- Walk through Building – during the Sunday Service the Attendant will walk through the Church building, up-stairs and down-stairs to ensure that there are no irregularities nor any individuals who do not need to be in various locations within the Church building.

Note: We purchase the backpacks in bulk at super-good prices, so there is no need to pay local retail prices. We'll have plenty of those, but we do need lots of the following. Prices drop when the stores set up their school supplies sections, but some may have good prices already. Online sources are also great.
